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## Training Opportunities

Jeff Stoll Public Health and Environment Consulting, LLC (JSPHEC) provides training for childcare centers. Each training opportunity can be customized for each center's needs and can are mostly 1 to 2 day trainings. The opportunity, Preparing for the OHS Environmental Health and Safety Review is the most involved with a minimum of 2 days but could be 3 or more depending on how comprehensive of a review of centers and classrooms is desired.

  - a. Outbreak Prevention in the Childcare Setting
    - i. Participants will learn about current diseases of concern for childcare settings.
    - ii. Participants will learn how diseases spread and how to use that knowledge to prevent disease

2. Safety and Injury Prevention
  - a. Hot Topics in Safety and Injury Prevention
    - i. Participants will learn about the current safety issues in childcare centers
    - ii. Participants will learn how to prevent and respond to these issues in their centers
  - b. Playground Safety
    - i. Participants will learn about standards for safe playgrounds
  - c. Food Safety
    - i. Participants will learn about foodborne diseases
    - ii. Participants will learn about practices and procedures for preparing, transporting and serving food safely
  - d. Emergency Preparedness
3. Compliance with Federal Childcare Standards
  - a. Preparing for the OHS Environmental Health and Safety Review
    - i. Participants will learn about the process and steps in a federal review
    - ii. Participants will learn how to behave during a federal review—interacting with reviewers and review team leaders
    - iii. Participants will be taken on a tour of their own center and classrooms from the perspective of a federal reviewer – dependent on the number of centers and classrooms.
    - iv. Participants will receive recommendations and learn how to develop plans for correcting non-compliant practices and situations
    - v. Learn how to implement a system of in-house monitoring for health and safety and compliance with standards
    - vi. Participants will learn how standards protect our children
